

Rockland Run Condominium's Pool Openings Guidelines

SUMMER 2024

New pool passes were issued two years ago. Older pool passes will not be accepted.

If you are an owner, you will need to provide proof of ownership (ID), and complete the attached pool registration form. Other occupants listed on your pool registration form may be required to provide ID for verification of residency.

If you are a tenant, you will need to bring a copy of your lease, proof of living on the property (ID, mail), and complete the attached pool registration form. Other occupants listed on your pool registration form may be required to provide ID for verification of residency.

Passes will only be given out to either the owner or the tenant. You will get one pool pass per legal occupant in your unit.

Two guests will be allowed per unit

Now for the rules we must put in place to make this happen. I know this is a long exhaustive list but we need to enforce these rules as not to jeopardize the pool season for those who enjoy the pool and most importantly, jeopardize the health and safety of our community.

- Every resident must have a current pool pass that represents their address at Rockland Run.
- All children under the age of twelve must be accompanied by their parent or guardian at all times.
- All residents are encouraged to shower prior to entering the pool. Please bring your own soap.
- The picnic tables may be used for either individual or family use. You must bring your own separate towel specifically for sitting in this area.
- If you have been sick or around someone who has been sick, please do not use the pool or pool area.

Our lifeguard will be solely responsible for the pool and any member of the Board of Directors may enforce the Rules of the Pool at any time.
